Holy Spirit Cemetery Burial Information

We offer two types of burials:

- a) plot and
- b) Columbarium (niche) currently unavailable as all completely filled. Additional structures will be forthcoming in the future.

Plots

Each plot is an in-ground burial. If one full body is buried in the plot, a second body (cremated only) can occupy the same plot.

Two **cremated** remains may also occupy the same plot.

The purchase price of the plot is **\$800** for contributing parishioner and **\$900** for non-parishioner. This price is whether one or two persons are buried in plot.


Additional costs: (average for the in-ground plot)

- a. Burial vault \$1,200
- b. Foundation for underneath headstone on grave \$250
- c. Monument or headstone \$2,500
- d. Opening and closing grave (\$700 for full body; \$350 for cremated remains)

 Total including the plot = \$5,800 (average)

The Columbarium

There are four statues in Holy Spirit cemetery, each one standing on a columbarium. The columbarium has an east side and a west side; each side houses six niches or cubbies. Within each niche, two urns can be placed.



Two urns may be placed in each niche

Cost for columbarium niche is **\$2500** for a parishioner and **\$3000** for non-parishioner. This **includes** a bronze plaque indicating the name of the deceased. Plaque may be ordered at any time after deceased is placed in niche; or families can wait until both are deceased and then family members order plaque.

One or two urns may be placed in the niche. There is an additional cost if the niche needs to be re-opened in the event that a second urn is placed within the niche (\$250). The sexton can verify this cost. These are the only costs associated with the niche.

Funeral home frequently utilized is **Borek Jennings** in Hamburg, but any funeral home can be chosen. Borek-Jennings – Hamburg – 810-231-0200.

Sexton is **Alex Nicholas – Nicholas Brothers Memorials**. 734-878-2940. All cemetery burials are performed by Nicholas Bros. Memorials as they also provide the foundations as well as the memorials or headstones.

This is a Catholic-only cemetery. Membership at a parish is also a consideration. By-laws explain in more detail.
